

Tao Cheng Wins Academic Poster Competition at 2012 Construction Industry Institute (CII) Annual Conference

The Academic Committee of the Construction Industry Institute (CII) invited university researchers to display posters highlighting their non-CII sponsored research in Construction Engineering and Project Management at the CII Annual Conference in Baltimore, Maryland July 23-25, 2012. The objective of the poster session was to introduce CII members to construction industry research activities which are outside topic areas of the present portfolio of projects funded by CII and also, to expose promising young researchers to CII membership.

Tao Cheng presented research on "Multiple-Sensor Data Fusion for Automatic Assessment of Safety and Productivity Performance of Construction Workers". This research is conducted by a team of university researchers at the University of Washington (Prof. Giovanni Migliaccio, Dr. Umberto Gatti), Georgia Institute of Technology (Prof. Jochen Teizer, Tao Cheng), and University of New Mexico (Prof. Susan Bogus, Dr. Suzanne Schneider).
